The 2019 edition will take place on August 24th and 25th!

SAVE THE DATE: The 2019 PEARL iZUMi 24 Hours Cycling of Le Mans will take place on 24th and 25th of August on the famous Bugatti circuit. Registrations will open on November 20th on www.24heuresvelo.fr/en/.

With a historical record of participation in 2018 and some forty teams remaining on the waiting list, you might have to hurry to get your bib.

A date not to be missed if riding the greatest number of laps in 24 hours on the exceptional coating of the Bugatti circuit is one of your goals of the season. More than 2500 riders from around 20 countries are expected to live this lifetime experience in team relay of 2, 4, 6 or 8, or even as a solo rider.

- Championnat de France des Clubs de la Défense : 114 participants – 2 hours of FCD race (8am to 10am)
- Bugatti circuit: 2600 miles - Uphill: 656 yd. from 3.5% to 7% - Downhill: 1094 yd. at 2%
- Visitors: Free entry - Access to the Village and the "spectator areas" at the edge of the track
