

Shimano 24 Hours Cycling (Le Mans) 2020 registrations will open on november 25th at 10am!

The Shimano 24 Hours Cycling 12th edition will take place on the Le Mans circuit, next 22nd and 23rd of August. Registrations will open the 25th November at 10am on www.24heuresvelo.fr.

560 is the maximum number of teams expected to start the race, including 80 single and 40 pairs. So if you are thinking about your goals for the coming season, note that a preferential rate will be offered to the 200 first registered teams.

A fully lighted and mythical circuit, the « Le Mans » start type, team relay or night ride experience...here are some of the ingredients that make up the Shimano 24 Hours Cycling recipe. Major partner since the creation of the event, Shimano will assist participants for the last mechanical adjustments, to fix bikes that need it during the race, and event to lend wheels in case of puncture.
